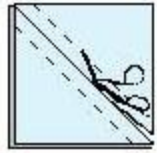


Mystery Quilt 2016-2017 Advanced Beginner - Clue #1

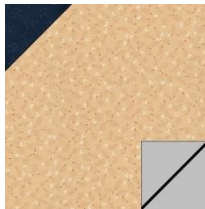
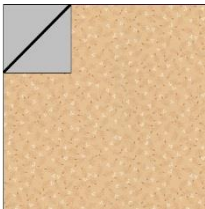
Sewing Instructions:

1. Make 40 Half Square Triangles (HST) by placing (1) 3 1/2" Background (CREAM) square on top of (1) 3 1/2" Feature (Assorted RED) square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" on each side of drawn line, cut apart on line, and press to red. Square up to 2 1/2".



Make 40, HST.

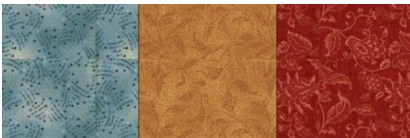
2. Make 20 Snowball blocks by placing (1) 2 1/2" Contrast (Assorted BLUE) square on one corner of (1) 6 1/2" Background (CREAM) square, right sides together. Sew on line. Cut seam allowance to 1/4", flip and press to Blue. Repeat on remaining corners. Square up to 6 1/2".



Make 20, LABEL: Snowball "A".

3. With a **RANDOM - in no certain order** - assortment of 2 1/2" Feature (Assorted REDS), Contrast (Assorted BLUES), and Coordinate (Assorted GOLDS), sew the following unit. Pressing will be done in Clue 5 before assembly is completed.

Examples:



Make 20, 3-patch units.
