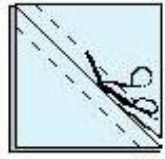


Mystery Quilt 2016-2017 Advanced Beginner - Clue #2

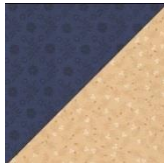
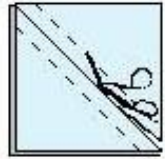
Sewing Instructions:

1. Make 40 more Half Square Triangles (HST) by placing (1) 3 1/2" Background (CREAM) square on top of (1) 3 1/2" Feature (Assorted RED) square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" on each side of drawn line, cut apart on line, and press to red. Square up to 2 1/2".



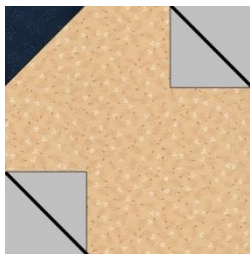
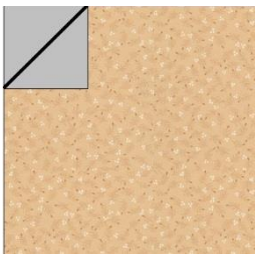
Make 40 HST

2. Make 20 Half Square Triangles (HST) by placing (1) 3 1/2" Background (CREAM) square on top of (1) 3 1/2" Feature (Assorted BLUES) square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" on each side of drawn line, cut apart on line, and press to blue. Square up to 2 1/2".



Make 20 HST

3. Make 4 more of the following block using (1) 6 1/2" Background (CREAM) square and (3) 2 1/2" Contrast (Assorted BLUE). Square up to 6 1/2".



Make 4, LABEL: Snowball "B".

4. Using **RANDOM -in no certain order** - 2 1/2" Assorted RED, BLUE, and GOLD squares, make 20 of the following unit. Pressing will be done in Clue 5 before assembly is completed

Make 20 3-patch units.
