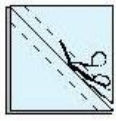


## Mystery Quilt 2016-2017 Advanced Beginner - Clue #4

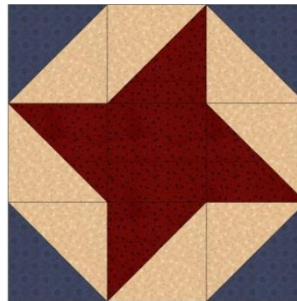
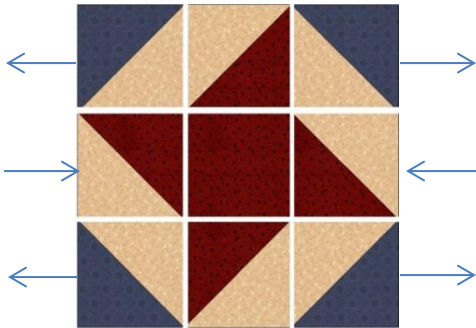
### Sewing Instructions:

1. Make 26 more Blue/Cream HST using (1) 3 1/2" Background CREAM and (1) 3 1/2" Contrast (Assorted BLUE) squares. **Square up to 2 1/2"**



Make 26 HST.

1. Make 5 more Star blocks using (1) 2 1/2" RED, (4) Blue/Cream HST and (4) Red/Cream HST. Pressing Instructions to nest seams: Before assembling the 9-patch star, press middle 3-patch row to center and top and bottom 3-patch rows to outside. After sewing 3-patch rows together, press seams to outside.



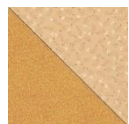
Make 5 Star Units. Your block should measure 6 1/2".

2. Make 12 more Red/Cream HST by using (1) 3 1/2" RED and (1) 3 1/2" CREAM squares. **Square up to 2 1/2"**



Make 12 HST.

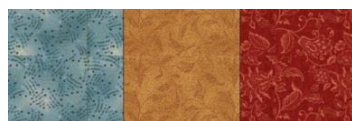
3. Make 12 Gold/Cream HST using (1) 3 1/2" CREAM and (1) 3 1/2" GOLD squares. **Square up to 2 1/2"**.



Make 12 HST.

4. Make 46 more units as shown below with **RANDOM - in no particular order** - red, blue, and gold squares: Pressing will be done in Clue 5 before assembly is completed.

Make 46 3-patch units.
