

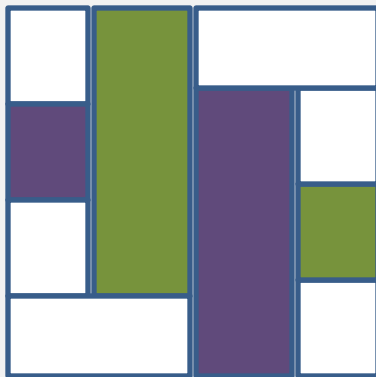
Mystery Quilt 2018 – Beginner – Clue 3

Clue 3, Step 2. **Block A:** Assemble 9

*Clue 3

1. Gather Units 1 and 2 completed in clues 1 and 2.
2. Assemble nine blocks as shown. Make sure to position Unit 1 on the left with the background rectangle on the bottom and Unit 2 on the right with the background rectangle on the top.

Press the seam allowances in the same direction for all blocks. Measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square. This is **Block A**.

*Clue 3

3. Gather the remaining forty-two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ", background squares, twenty-one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " coordinate-A rectangles, and twenty-one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " coordinate-B rectangles.
4. Sew one background square to one end of each coordinate-A rectangles. Press the seam allowances toward background fabric. See pressing arrows. Measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". This is **Unit 3**.
5. Sew one background square to one end of each coordinate-B rectangle. Press the seam allowances toward background fabric. See pressing arrows. Measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". This is **Unit 4**.
