## The Rolling Star Block



The Rolling Star Block is made with the two units, Unit 1-A and Unit 1-B, the square in a square (in two different shadings) and a "9-patch" in the center. You will be making 30 Rolling Star blocks.

One thing that makes this block a bit tricky to assemble is the fact that when you join square in a square to another square in a square you have no butted seams that can help with proper placement. All those points NEED to be pinned. Use small pins for patchwork matching. See the pinning images below:

## Pinning Example



Step 1: Run a pin through both points with the units right sides together. Align upper edges of units even with each other.

Step 2: Holding first pin in place, take a second pin and pin through all layers just next to the first pin.

Step 3: Remove first pin. All layers are secured by second pin.

Step 4: Sew.


## Block Layout

1. Make $\mathbf{3 0}$ "Rolling Star Blocks" by laying out units as shown.
2. Use the pinning method above to match the points as you sew units in a "9-patch" format, sewing the units into rows, and then joining the rows to form each block.
3. Press seams towards the 4 corners, the blue center squares. (Away from the Pink/brown squares)
4. Verify the blocks measure $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
