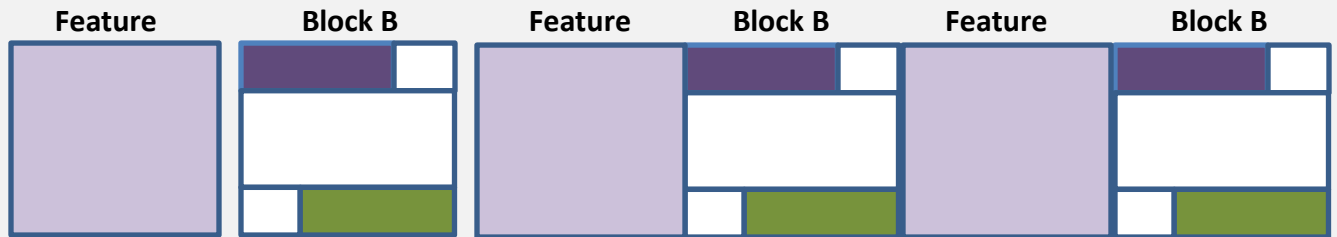


Mystery Quilt 2018 – Beginner Clue 5

Clue 5

* Clue 5 – Part 1

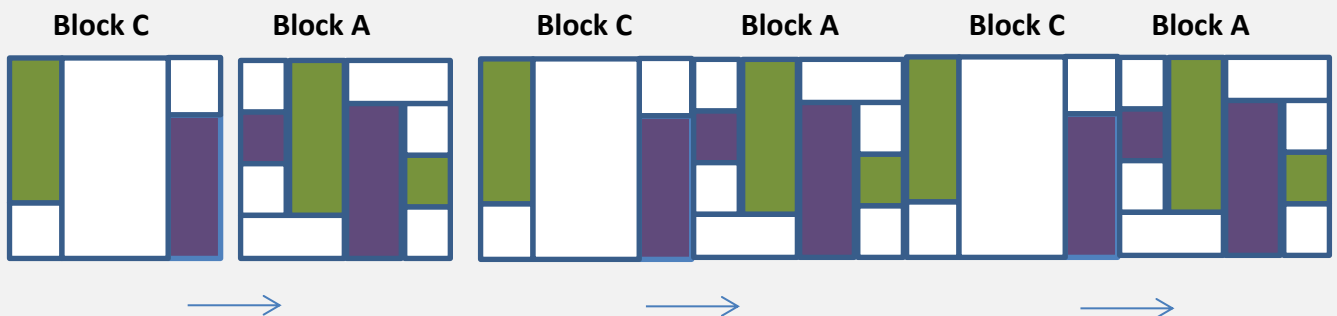
1. Gather the 12 B-blocks completed in clue 4 and twelve 8 ½" x 8 ½" feature squares.
2. Sew four rows with three B-blocks and three feature squares. Alternate the squares with the blocks, beginning with a feature square and ending with a B-block. Press the seam allowances and follow the pressing arrows. This is **Row X**.



Clue 5, **Row X**: Assemble 4

* Clue 5 – Part 2

1. Gather nine A-blocks and nine C-blocks.
 2. Sew three rows as shown. Alternate the blocks, beginning with a C-block and ending with an A-block.
- Pay close attention to the positions of the blocks. The coordinate-A rectangle in the C-blocks should be on the upper left. The coordinate-B rectangle in the A-blocks should be on the bottom right. Press the seam allowances and follow the pressing arrows. This is **Row Y**.



Clue 5, **Row Y**: Assemble 3.
