

'Murder at the Quilt Retreat'

Greetings from the Mystery Quilt Committee. We are doing something new this year with the Mystery Quilt Project. Instead of a full-sized quilt, the finished project will be about 44 inches square. Each month in addition to the directions, participants will receive a chapter from our murder mystery, "Murder at the Quilt Retreat".

Participants must register to receive a chapter of the story each month. The directions will be available on the guild website, but the story will not be published. Part of the registration includes donating a fat quarter of a pretty fabric, towards a May drawing. Each registered participant will have their name entered into the drawing when the fat quarter is received by committee members.

Additional opportunities are available to have participants names placed in the drawing. Your name can be entered multiple times for the drawing in May. Below are some ways to have your name entered multiple times.

- 1) Show and share your monthly segment. This can be accomplished in four different ways.
 - A) Show and Share the monthly segment at a guild meeting, either in person or virtually.
 - B) Texting a picture to a committee member.
 - C) Emailing a picture to a committee member
 - D) Posting a picture on the guild's facebook page.
- 2). If the mystery project is fully assembled by the May meeting, two entries will be given.
- 3). An entry will be given for each correct guess to the clues of a). Who committed the murder, b) where did the murder occur and c) What was the instrument of death. This could result in a total of entries.

If a participant completes ALL chances for the drawing (excluding the guesses), their name will be entered into a special drawing. Please join us this year for 'Murder at the Quilt Retreat'. You may register by sending your fat quarter to Beverly Beidel.
